
The competition aims to inspire students to strive for excellence in their studies and to encourage them to develop their professional knowledge base and contacts to benefit future careers.

OptiStudent Awards



- Students work on a contact lens and anterior eye related topic of their choice.
- Each university select a student/team to represent it and compete with other universities to become the country representative(s).
- The representatives from each country will compete at the EMEA OptiStudent Awards Final.
- The overall winner/team will be awarded with the title of **OptiStudent of the Year 2024**.



The Iberia competition



- The competition is for all First degree students in Optometry in Portuguese and Spanish universities, for the last two courses students (enrolled in May 2023 or October 2023)
- Students can enter individually or in a pair
- The theme of the project must be about **Soft Contact Lenses**
- The student must present a paper in English, Portuguese or Spanish
- The Iberia winner must present an abstract in English





The Iberia Final

- Each university will choose the winner project that will represent its university in the Iberia final
- Iberia winner will be chosen by the supervisors of the Iberia universities that have participated in the competition in 2024 edition
- Winners will be chosen according to the assessment criteria
- Iberia Winner will join other country finalists at the EMEA OptiStudent Awards Final in Budapest*





The EMEA final

All the national winners **will meet in Budapest** to compete against the winners from each country in the EMEA final.

Each national winner need to present their project with **Powerpoint in 15 minutes, with a 15 minutes' Q&A session** to defend their work. The judging panel will assess according to the assessment criteria.

Finally, the judging panel will announce the winner at an exclusive dinner where they will be given their award of a complimentary trip to an international clinical conference and will be awarded the title of CooperVision **OptiStudent of the Year**.



Winning the EMEA Final opens the access to a free year's BCLA membership fee. **Participation to the EMEA Final is subject to approval by the organizing team.**

2024 competition guidelines

Aim of the study

The theme of the project must be in the field of contact lenses and anterior eye.*

Type of project

- *Clinical study:* Careful thought and planning should be given to the trial, as it is difficult to change once committed. Read more about the criteria that will be used to judge the clinical trial.
- **Case Report:** The case report should relate to a patient being treated by the student or his/her supervisor. The judging criteria are like those in the other category.

Guidelines

- Topic:
- Be careful not to cover controversial topics that have not yet been discussed by clinicians (PFAS, COVID, Microplastic,...)
- Anything <u>off label</u> or with potential IP issues will not be included for consideration.

Off label definition: relating to the prescription of a contact lens for a condition other than that for which it has been officially approved (ex: MiSight 1 day for presbyopia)

- Limit comparative performance studies between lenses, as manufacturers already have solid data. Judges intend to highlight more clinical research.
- Examples of interesting topics: presbyopia / astigmat wearers / artificial intelligence
- Study method:
- Be sure that you'll use normalized / validated techniques / questionnaires / statistic tools to drive your study
- Encourage research based on technical specifications provided by manufacturers. Data deemed more sensitive may be refused. (Optical zones size, UV, ...)
